Proclamation

"CBC RADIO ORCHESTRA MONTH"

- AND WHEREAS *There have been many occasions when the CBC Radio Orchestra of Vancouver has overcome financial and other challenges to its continued existence while other radio orchestras in Winnipeg, Toronto and Halifax have ceased to exist;*
- AND WHEREAS *The CBC Radio Orchestra of Vancouver is the last remaining radio orchestra, not only in Canada but in the whole of North America;*
- AND WHEREAS *The citizens of Vancouver have embraced the artistic excellence of the CBC Radio Orchestra of Vancouver and have thereby become culturally enriched;*
- AND WHEREAS *The CBC Radio Orchestra of Vancouver has contributed to the cultural and artistic reputation of Vancouver, both nationally and internationally;*
- AND WHEREAS *The City of Vancouver wishes to reinforce a national awareness of the historical and current contribution of the CBC Radio Orchestra of Vancouver to the cultural fibre of this city and the whole of Canada;*
- AND WHEREAS *The City of Vancouver and its citizens wish to wholeheartedly support the continuation of this cultural legacy;*
- NOW, THEREFORE, *I, Samuel Sullivan, Mayor of the City of Vancouver, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM the month of June, 2008 as*
